Loose Parts

Loose parts are materials that can be moved, carried, combined, redesigned, lined up, taken apart and put together in multiple ways.



Materials can be natural or synthetic. Examples are stones, stumps, sand, gravel, fabric, twigs, wood, pallets, balls, buckets, crates, boxes, logs, stones, flowers, rope, tires, balls, shells and seedpods.



They are materials with no specific set of directions that can be used alone or combined with other materials.

They have no defined use, and children are free to change the shape and style of them.



Loose parts create endless possibilities and invites creativity. For example, if a child picks up a rock and starts to play, most likely that rock can become anything the child wants it to be. Imagination, creativity, curiosity, desire, and need are the motivation of loose parts.

Children playing with loose parts are using more creativity and imagination and developing more skill and competence than they would be playing with most modern plastic toys.
